We thank the parents who, as their first teachers, have entrusted their children to our school and faith formation programs.

Thanks to all who have already bought tickets in our upcoming Parish Raffle.

Congratulations to the newly ratified members of the Parish Pastoral Council. We are proud of all those willing to serve the parish in this capacity. *See insert.*

I am happy to note that we have now completed the payment of our CMA goal. We have, in fact, overpaid our goal by **\$800.00** and therefore will receive **half** that amount back from the Diocese.

There is \$1,445.00 still outstanding in pledges. If any of this is paid to the CMA, we will get nothing but it will entirely be credited to next year's CMA goal.

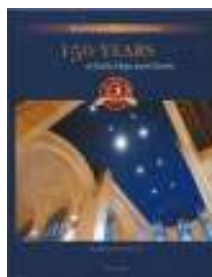

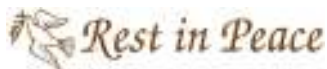

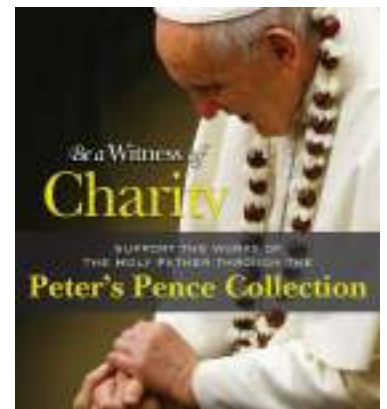
