



### **Children's Liturgy of the Word**

During the 10:00 Sunday Mass, the children in grades preschool through 4th grade are called after the opening prayer to the parish center to celebrate the Liturgy of the Word on their level. Parent facilitators help the children become familiar with basic prayers and hymns. They lead child friendly discussions based on the Sunday Scripture readings which the children hear in age-appropriate language that they can understand. The guided discussions enable the children to understand how the Gospel message relates to their everyday experiences.

Parent involvement is encouraged and welcome! *If you feel called to share your love of Jesus through his Holy Word, we offer training and resources to prepare you for this rewarding ministry.*
