At least two people should be present for each of the four hours of Adoration.

Come, bring your prayer book or your bible. Pray the rosary, pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet, pray for an end to abortion, for religious vocations, or for our country. Or just sit and talk with our Lord about the things happening in your life.

Remember the word ACTS:

Adoration, **C**ontrition, **T**hanksgiving, and **S**upplication.
