



Hand Bell Choir

The Handbell Choir is a multigenerational group, beginners to advanced players, grade 3 - adult, who play at one Mass each week on a rotating schedule and at other special functions in, and outside, the parish. Some of these functions have included weddings, Confirmation, Mass at Sacred Heart Cathedral and concerts.

The handbell choir is a “team” instrument so a very strong commitment to the team of at least a full year (from September to June) is expected. Beginners need not have music reading skills to start; those wishing to ring with the more advanced ringers must have strong music reading skills and a good sense of rhythm. Flexibility in schedule for weekend liturgies is crucial.

Rehearsals are Tuesday evenings at 7:15 PM. Beginner’s rehearsal starts at 6:15 PM to work on music reading and bell handling skills.
