Pastoral Planning: Highlighting the Keeping in Touch Ministry of St. Lawrence

St. Lawrence's Keeping in Touch (KIT) ministry is part of the parish's Faith in Action committee. KIT members provide regular visits and bring Holy Communion to homebound parishioners living in private homes, senior living facilities, group homes, and hospitals. Some members lead Communion services and Rosary groups in apartment complexes at Greece Gardens at Town Center and The Village at Mill Landing. Others visit Unity Hospital, Wegmans Cottages at Unity, and The Villages at Unity, or other facilities if requested. At Christmas the KIT ministry provides Prayer Partners with poinsettias; members also reach out with cards, phone calls, and bulletins throughout the year. Parishioners or their family ministries are encouraged to contact the parish rectory to arrange KIT services. Presently about 15 volunteers visit about 75 Prayer Partners. All agree it is a blessing to share the Love of God and His Precious Body.
